For 10 years I worked at the Smithsonian Institution, Cooper-Hewitt National Design Museum managing the permanent collection of 250,000+ objects across a wide range of disciplines. For the past 14+ years I have single-handily managed, as the registrar and collections curator, a large Private Collection of 1300+ objects and 600+ rare and rare and antiquarian books in multiple locations. The majority of the collection is comprised of late 19th and early 20th c. vintage prints, drawings, and photographs. The collection also holds late 19th c. and 20th c. paintings, mixed-media works, sculpture, Native American pottery and contemporary ceramics. I am responsible for complete management and care of the collection, including cataloguing, physical care, database management, risk management, loans and exhibitions.
