From collaborating directly with private owners to navigating challenges without the framework of museum governance, the discussion will explore how collection care, documentation, and conservation are adapted outside of traditional settings.

Whether addressing the demands of a private estate or a corporate collection, the fundamental goal remains the same: preserving and protecting cultural heritage. This session will shed light on the distinct workflows, expectations, and opportunities present in private collections, while reaffirming the shared professional values at the heart of our field.

- Can take years to complete and may encompass: appraisal, insurance review, conservation + re-framing/mounts and housing, research to complete the catalogue (raisonné/expertise applications), environmental (monitor/amend), manage loan requests,, strategy and succession planning ...

- Continued at college art museum – curatorial asst > acting registrar initiated project to computerize records.
- Senior January Term > MET Far Eastern Art led to CV Starr Fellowship
- Kress Fellowship at British Museum- discovered my predilection for preventative conservation vs. repair
- Left BM + the field > worked for an art advisor in NYC where I was introduced to the world of private collections
